#### 7. Members Forum and Christmas Preview

Mark will be selling the turkeys in a bag that the customer can keep and that also makes the turkeys look more impressive - £1.00 added to overall costs to soak up the bag costs. 10% added onto prices to allow for error. Moved all marketing to in house - rented a printer and does all his own marketing information.

Addy's - Online choice which will be an extension to the current website, an online clicking selection that the customer can complete. Not producing a brochure.
